RULES & REGULATIONS

A. Registration:

- 1. All complete registration forms must be submitted to UM Floorball Open organising committee by 8th November 2016.
- 2. Registration Fee for each team will be RM300.00.
- 3. Registration to be handed in via email to peiyicheah@gmail.com
- 4. Late registrations after the closing date (8th November 2016) will not be entertained.
- 5. Participants must present their valid **student/matrix card** during the game day.

B. Players Eligibility

- 1. Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute.
- 2. Former students of the institutions mentioned above who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the same year only.
- 3. Be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age as of year.

C. Team:

- 1. The competition will be competed in two categories
 - Men's inter-varsity
 - Women's inter-varsity.
- 2. Each team will consist of no more than 16 players (including goalkeepers).
- 3. Only registered players and officials will be allowed in the substitution zones.
- 4. It will be a 5 on 5 tournament. (5 outfield players + 1 goalkeeper)
- 5. Teams must have two sets of jersey throughout the tournament.
- 6. All field players in a team shall wear the exact same jersey. If the referees consider that the teams cannot be distinguished by their uniforms, the visiting team is obliged to change.
- 7. A team's jerseys shall be numbered with different whole numbers in clearly visible Arabic figures at back of the jersey.
- 8. Changes to jersey colours will not be entertained unless consent is given by the organizing committee.
- 9. All matches will be played in the multipurpose hall of block A, Sports Centre, University of Malaya.
- 10. Besides the above, all other rules and regulations will be based on the official IFF Rules and Regulations but the organizers reserve the right to amend or change accordingly.
- 11. The organisers assume no responsibility for personal injuries or loss of belongings, arising from the participation in the league or activities related to the league.

D. Matches:

- 1. No time-out is allowed.
- 2. Teams must be in the arena at least one match before. Failing to do so will result in a walkover.
- 3. When a walkover is at hand, the match is forfeited and the opponent shall be considered having won the match with the result 5-0.
- 4. Warm up is not allowed on court.
- 5. Duration for matches will be 18 minutes non- effective time. Only one period.

D. Managers Meeting

1. Managers meeting will take place at 7.30am sharp on 13 November 2016.

E. Others

- 1. Only IFF approved sticks will be allowed in this tournament.
- 2. Besides the above, all other rules and regulations will be based on the official IFF Rules and Regulations.
- 3. Should there be any matter arising or question that arises at any point, the decision made by the organiser shall be final.
- 4. The organiser assumes no responsibility for personal injuries or loss of belongings, arising from the participation in the league or activities related to the league.

F. Prizes:

- 1. Champions will receive challenge trophy.
- 2. Medals will be given to Champions, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner up.
