



UNIVERSITY OF MALAYA FLOORBALL OPEN 2014

UPDATED RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Team:

1. All field players in a team shall wear the exact same jersey. If the referees consider that the teams cannot be distinguished by their uniforms, **the visiting team is obliged to change**. Bibs will be provided.
2. A team's jerseys shall be numbered with different whole numbers in clearly visible Arabic figures.
3. Changes to jersey colours will not be entertained unless consent is given by the organizing committee.

B. Groups:

1. Matches will be played in a round robin in each group. For the men's category, **top 2 teams from each group and 2 best 3rd placed teams (Points, goal difference, goal scored) will qualify to the knock-out stage.**
2. For the women's category, **top 2 teams will qualify to final. The 3rd and 4th teams will play for 3rd-4th placing.**

C. Matches:

1. No time-out is allowed.
2. Teams must be in the arena at least **one match before**. Failing to do so will result in a **walkover**.
3. When a walkover is at hand, the match is forfeited and the opponent shall be considered having won the match with the result 5-0.
4. Warm up is not allowed on court.
5. Duration for matches will be **17 minutes non- effective time for group stage** and **22 minutes non-effective for knock-out stage** (quarter, semi, 3rd place match, final)

D. Managers Meeting

1. Managers meeting will take place at **8am sharp** on 15 Nov (men's) and 16 Nov (women's)

E. Others

1. Only IFF approved sticks will be allowed in this tournament.
2. Besides the above, all other rules and regulations will be based on the official IFF Rules and Regulations.
3. Should there be any matter arising or question that arises at any point, the decision made by University of Malaya Floorball shall be final.
4. University of Malaya Floorball assumes no responsibility for personal injuries or loss of belongings, arising from the participation in the league or activities related to the league.

F. Prizes:

1. Champions will receive challenge trophy.
2. Medals will be given to Champions, Runner Up and 3rd Placing.
3. Prize money for men's category will be RM 400, RM 200 and RM 100 respectively. While prize money for women's category will be RM 300 and RM 150 respectively.
